Sophie and I had a very exciting meeting this week with the team from Bug Blitz. John and Erin partnered with us to put in a successful submission for an Active Schools Grant. The grant will enable us to have one day a week for 2 terms working with these scientists in locations at school and around the Gippsland lakes and wetlands.

Each time we have partnered with Bug Blitz in the past the students have come away with an increased respect and knowledge of our local environment. This opportunity for our students to work with the team, out in the field, for an extended period, will give our students so many varied learning experiences that it will feed into our learning for the whole second semester.

We are still in the planning stage and hope to partner with local groups and organisations to use as much local knowledge and make as many connections as possible.

This is such a one-of-a-kind experience that will benefit our students in so many ways.
